# Expose' Dance Centre

The Expose' Dance Centre aims to:

“Provide students with a rounded education in various dance styles whilst ensuring students are able to dance in a fun safe dance environment, be challenged and develop a love of dance.”

The Expose' Dance Centre follows the Ballet Australasia Limited and Cecchetti dance syllabus. Classes follow “Dance Safe” practices.

Exams : Exams are not compulsory but students are encouraged to participate. It gives students a better understanding and development in dance technique. If students are studying for exams, regular attendance is required.

Please note: Students in these classes must wear the correct dance uniform for their classes each week plus hire the required exam uniform if ready to sit the exam. Please ask the office for the correct uniform requirements.

Competitions: Competitions are not compulsory. If a student wishes to be involved in competitions, this must be discussed at the start of the year. Students must be taking ballet to be able to compete. Competitions are fun but do require commitment from the child and for the parent.

\*Recreational classes are available for those who only wish to dance for fun rather than pursue a career in dance. Recreational students are required to wear a uniform with the exception of hip hop & breaking students.

Fees: Payable in advance. Please read our fees policy for exact fee amounts & terms and conditions of payment.

Cancellations: can only be done in writing to the office. Failure to do so by cancellation date will result in you paying full term fees for following term.



**Uniform:** All students are required to attend classes in the Expose' Dance Centre uniform. No other uniform/dancewear is accepted. Students are not permitted to dance if

**Combination Classes/kinder ballet:** Hair in a bun, pink leather ballet shoes with elastics. Expose' pink leotard with attached skirt. Pink Expose' cross over.

**Exam ballet:** Hair in a neat ballet bun, pink leather ballet shoes with elastics. Expose' Blue (Grades pre primary - Grade 4) & Expose' Black (Grade 5 and above) with matching skirt. Expose' cross over in black. Black Expose' Dance jackets are to be worn at conventions and on exam day.

### Jazz/Tap & Acro:

Expose' Blue (Junior/Inters ) & Expose' Black (Seniors) with matching shorts. Expose' cross over in black. Students may wear Expose' Dance jacket instead of the cross over.

### Shoes:

Tan Jazz/Tap shoes. Acro students need to have clean sneakers.

### Hip hop & Break dancing (breaking)

Students may only wear loose suitable clothing. Recommend shorts & t-shirt or tracksuit. Need to have clean sneakers



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**OPEN DAYS:** Classes are normally closed to spectators. Open days occur on the last week of term's 1 & 2 only.

**Concert:** Concerts are a fun time for the students to show case all that they have learnt throughout the year.

We expect all students are participating unless written notification from parents by the end of term 2 is given. Parents agree to having their child participate they need to pay a non – refundable concert levy of \$25 (if in one routine) or \$50 (2 + routines). This enables us to purchase materials, organize costumes to be made and to help store & launder costumes.

The concert is a fun event that teaches the students teamwork, performance skills and more importantly develops self esteem and confidence.

Parents will pay \$25 per costume hire & \$35 for ballet plus GST. Costumes will be made for students to hire from the dancing school. Parents/students must be prepared to pay for their own shoes, hairpieces, tights and make up.

The concerts will be held on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> October (Juniors) & Saturday 1st December (Senior) at Xavier college, kew 135 Barkers rd kew. Juniors will only perform in one show, Senior students must be able to perform in both matinee and evening shows. Full terms and conditions will be available in term 2.

Parents may be asked to alter costumes to fit, sew sequines or other small accessories if required.

ALL Costumes MUST be returned to the Expose' Dance Centre after the concert.
